where does my help come from?

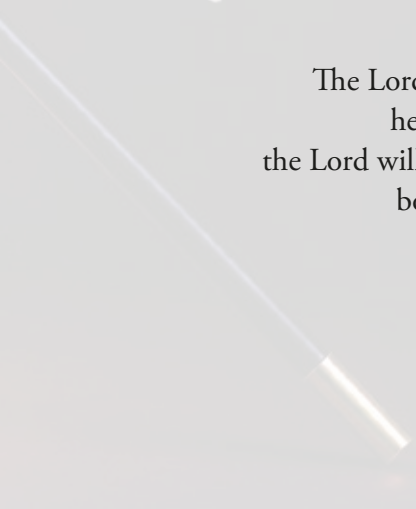
My help comes from the Lord,

on earth as it is in heaven.

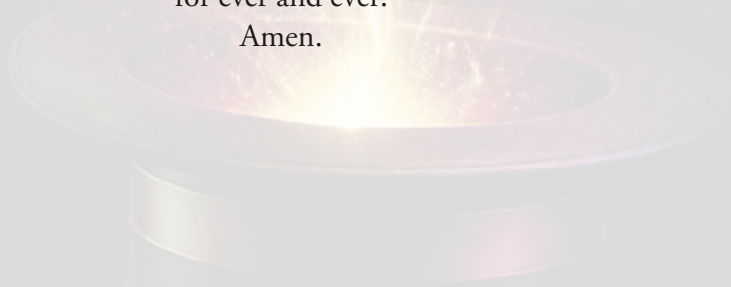
Give us this day our daily bread.

Butterfly Kisses

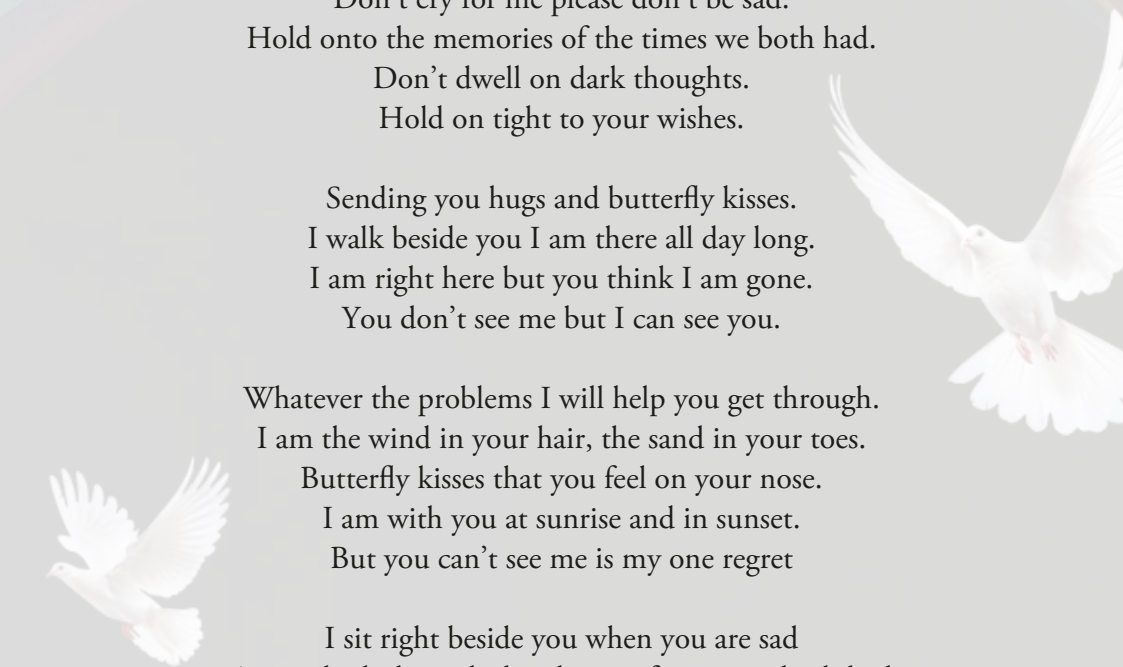
Don't cry for me please don't be sad.
