

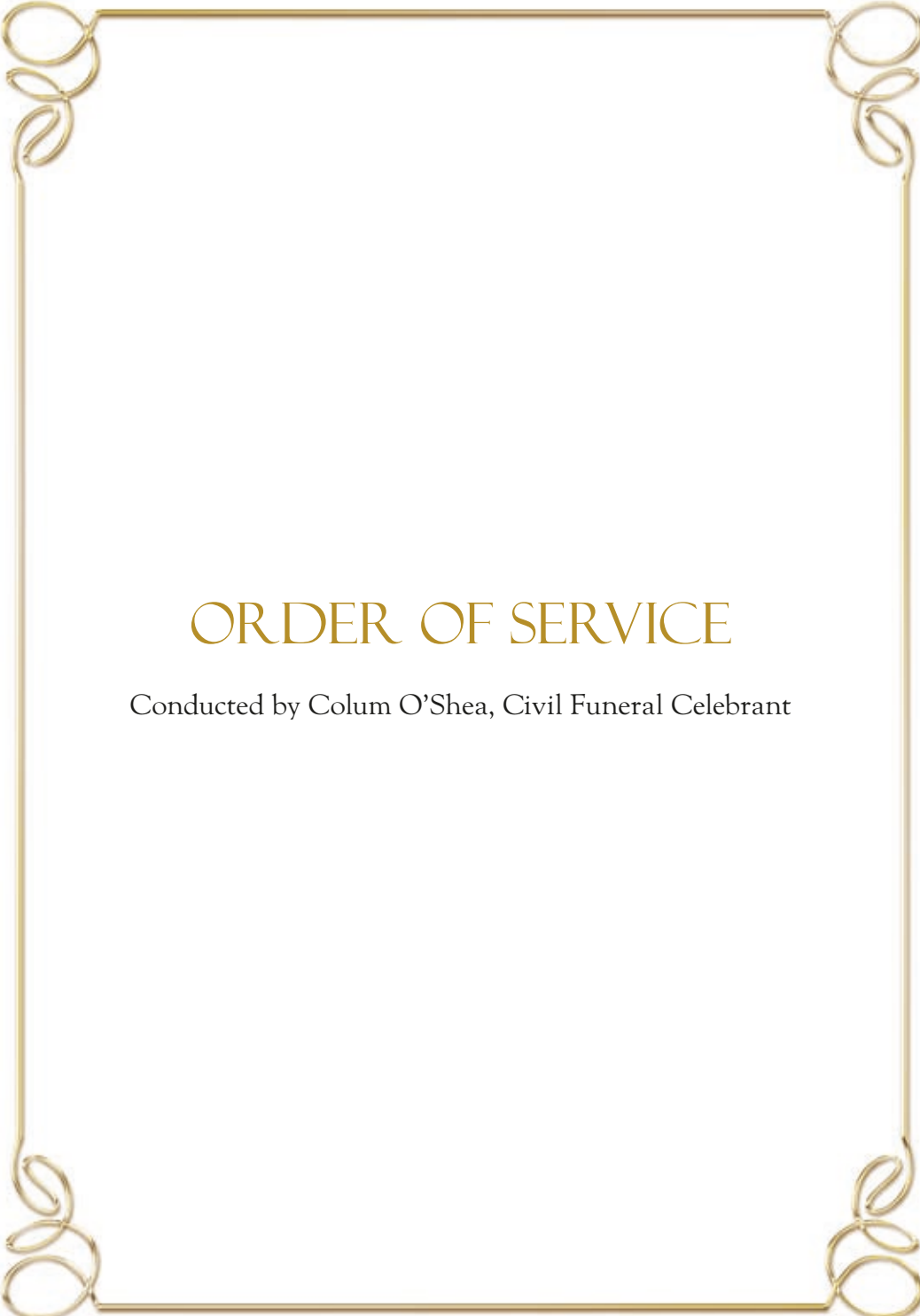

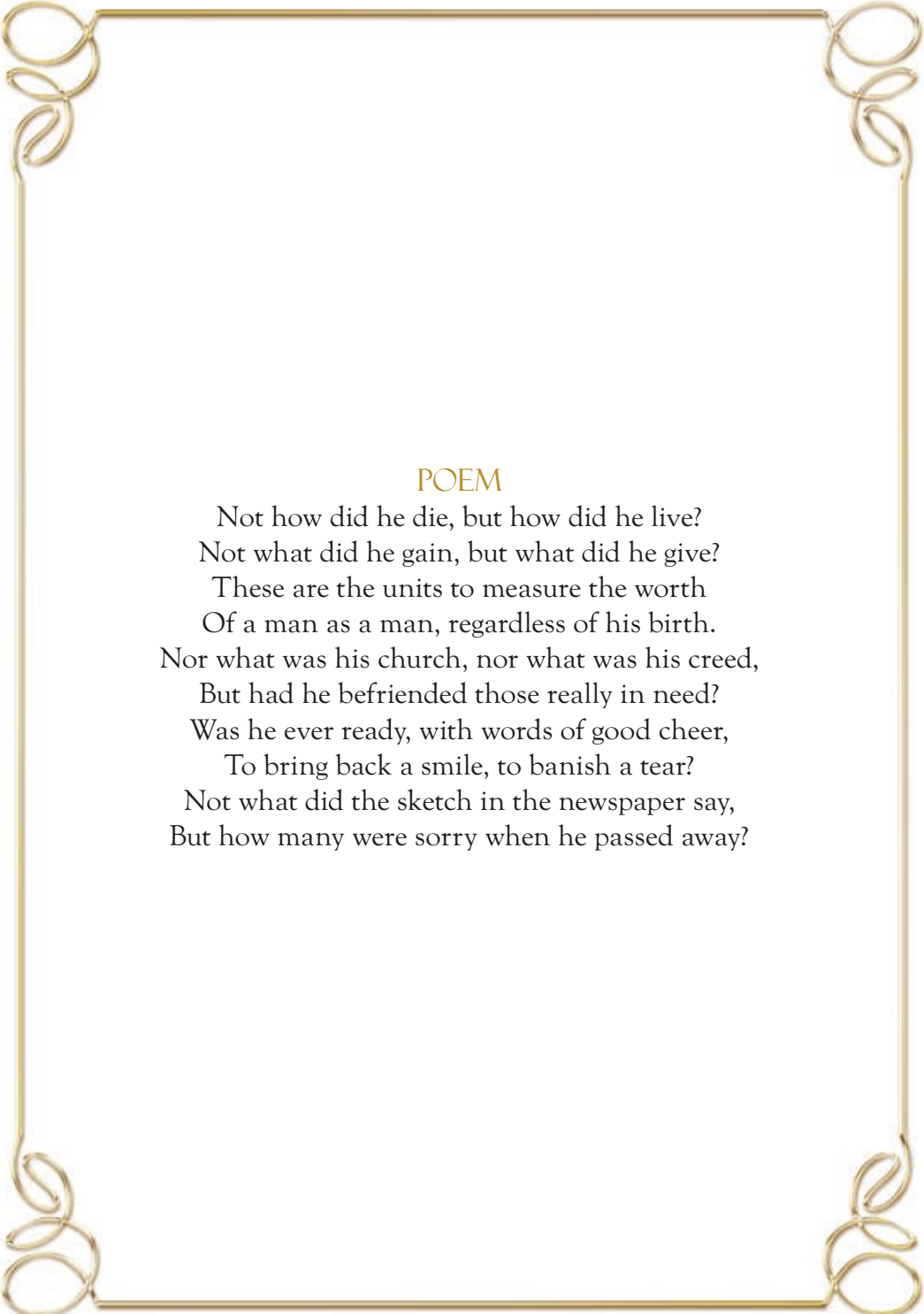

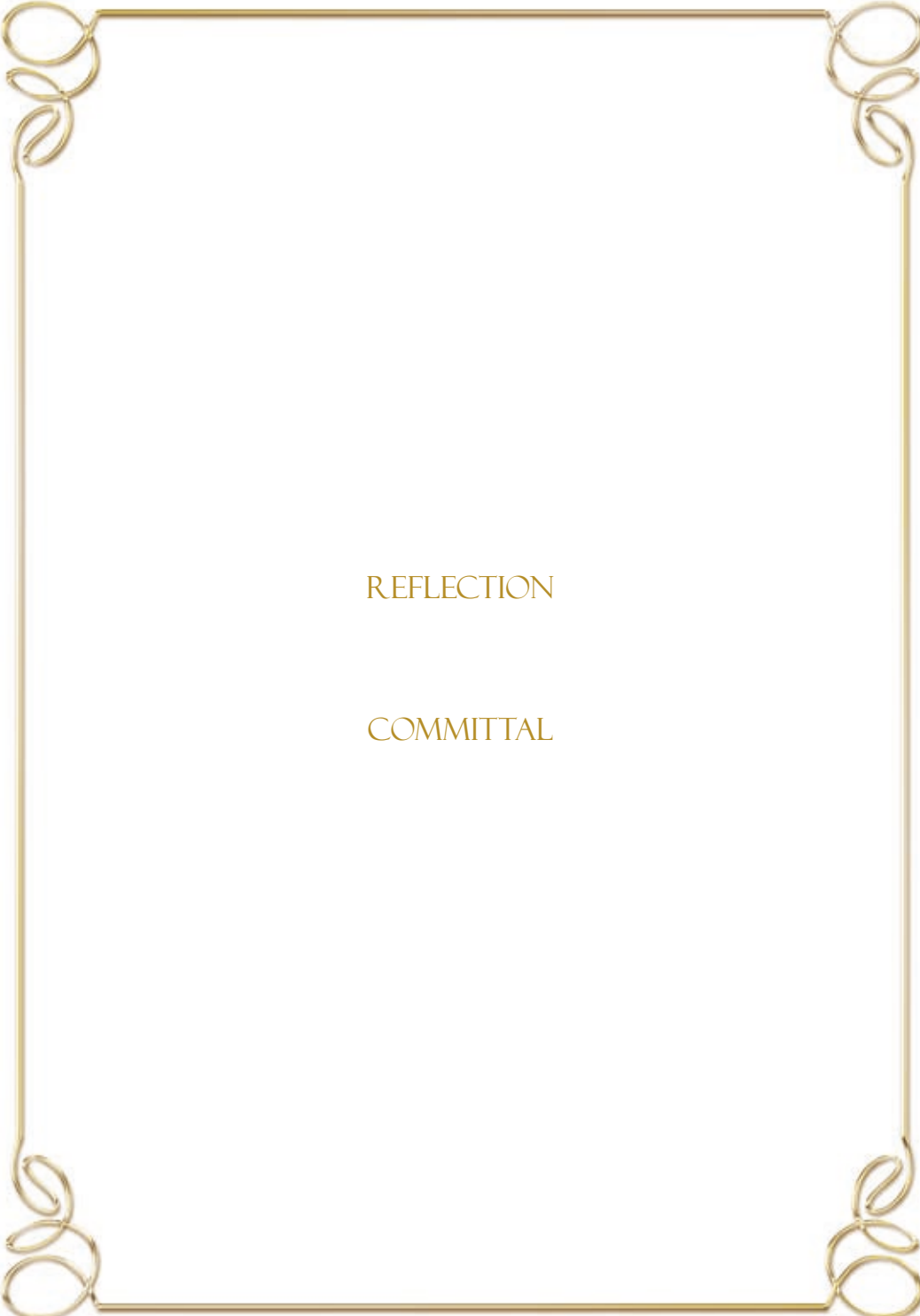
POEM
