EULOGY

IN REMEMBRANCE OF A LIFE SO BEAUTIFULLY LIVED, A LIFE FILLED WITH SELFLESS LOVE, UNWAVERING DEDICATION, AND BOUNDLESS GENEROSITY, WE GATHER TO CELEBRATE DR. (MRS) PASTOR ADERONKE OLUFUNMILOLA MOSURO. BORN ON THE 12TH OF JUNE 1965 IN ILE-IFE, NIGERIA, RONKE, AS SHE WAS AFFECTIONATELY KNOWN, BEGAN HER JOURNEY AS A BEACON OF LOVE AND BRILLIANCE AND OVER THE YEARS, SHE TOUCHED COUNTLESS LIVES WITH HER KINDNESS AND GRACE.

HER ACADEMIC PURSUITS LED HER TO EXCEL AT EVERY LEVEL,
FROM HER EARLY EDUCATION IN IBADAN TO OBTAINING A
MASTER'S DEGREE WITH DISTINCTION AND LATER A
DOCTORATE IN NUTRITION AND BIOCHEMISTRY. HER
COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION AND SERVICE WAS EVIDENT IN
HER ROLES AT VARIOUS INSTITUTIONS, WHERE SHE POSITIVELY
IMPACTED STUDENTS AND COLLEAGUES ALIKE.

ADERONKE'S LOVE STORY WITH HER HUSBAND, AYODEJI
MOSURO, WAS ONE OF DEVOTION AND RESILIENCE,
OVERCOMING CHALLENGES AND DISTANCES TO BUILD A
STRONG AND ENDURING BOND. TOGETHER, THEY RAISED A
BEAUTIFUL FAMILY FILLED WITH LOVE AND LAUGHTER,
NURTURING THEIR CHILDREN, ADEDAMOLA, ANJOLAOLUWA,
AND OLUWATOMISIN.

THE MOSURO FAMILY'S RELOCATION TO THE UNITED KINGDOM OPENED A NEW HORIZON FOR ADERONKE. SHE EMBRACED CHALLENGES WITH UNWAVERING FAITH AND A SMILE THAT COULD DISPEL THE DENSEST FOG. HER HOME AT 70 HARPTREE DRIVE BECOME A SANCTUARY OF KINDNESS, A TESTAMENT TO HER BOUNDLESS GENEROSITY. HER HEART KNEW NO BOUNDS, HER HOME NO STRANGERS — ONLY FRIENDS AND FAMILY YET TO BE KNOWN.

EULOGY

AS A DEVOTED SERVANT OF GOD, ADERONKE'S FAITH WAS HER COMPASS. HER SERVICE AS A PASTOR WAS MARKED BY AN ABIDING LOVE FOR ALL PEOPLE, AN UNWAVERING COMMITMENT TO THE SPIRITUAL GROWTH OF HER PARISHIONERS, AND A DEDICATION TO COMMUNITY THAT KNEW NO LIMITS.

IN HER LIFE'S JOURNEY, ADERONKE TRIUMPHED OVER SICKLE CELL ANAEMIA WITH A FORTITUDE THAT INSPIRED ALL. SHE LIVED NOT AS A PATIENT, BUT AS A WARRIOR, ARMED WITH GRACE AND GRATITUDE, A TRUE EMBODIMENT OF COURAGE.

DR. (MRS) PASTOR ADERONKE OLUFUNMILOLA MOSURO WAS
A PORTRAIT OF VIRTUE – A DEVOTED WIFE, A NURTURING
MOTHER, AN ACADEMIC PARAGON, AND A SHEPHERD IN
CHRIST'S FLOCK. HER DEPARTURE ON THE 3RD OF FEBRUARY
2024 IS NOT AN END BUT A CELESTIAL COMMENCEMENT. SHE
LEAVES BEHIND NOT JUST A LEGACY OF ACHIEVEMENTS, BUT A
LEGACY OF VIRTUES THAT WILL FOREVER FLOURISH IN THE
HEARTS OF THOSE SHE TOUCHED. AS WE BID FAREWELL TO
THIS REMARKABLE JEWEL OF INESTIMABLE VALUE, LET US
CARRY FORWARD THE TORCH OF HER LOVE, HER KINDNESS,
AND HER UNWAVERING FAITH.

COMMITMENT TO A HIGH CALLING OVER SO MANY YEARS AS A
PASTOR. WITH ADMIRATION WE RECALL HER LIFE-LONG SENSE
OF DUTY AND DEDICATION TO HER PEOPLE. WITH
THANKSGIVING WE PRAISE GOD FOR HER CONSTANT EXAMPLE
OF CHRISTIAN FAITH AND DEVOTION. WITH AFFECTION WE
RECALL HER LOVE FOR HER FAMILY AND HER COMMITMENT TO
THE CAUSES SHE HELD DEAR.

NOW, IN SILENCE, LET US IN OUR HEARTS AND MINDS RECALL
OUR MANY REASONS FOR THANKSGIVING, PRAY FOR ALL
MEMBERS OF HER FAMILY, AND COMMEND ADERONKE



Health and Safety EVACUATION ROUTES AND PROCEDURES



In the unlikely event that an emergency evacuation of the Church becomes necessary, an announcement will be made by a Church Officer. Follow the instructions given and those of the Church Officers. Should there be anyone near you requiring assistance offer your help or draw the matter to the attention of the Church Officers. Remain in your place until you are instructed by the Church Officers to leave the Church by one of the Fire Exits shown on the floor plan above. Keep calm and quiet so that additional instructions can be heard. Once outside make your way to the Archbishops' Palace Garden (North Porch and West Door Exits) or the College Road Car Park (Tower Door and Outer Vestry Door Exits where further instructions will be given. Should you want any assistance please speak to one of the Church Officers. Attend carefully to all announcements for your own safety and that of others.

CHILDREN

We are especially pleased to welcome children to this wonderful historic building. Remember that All Saints Church was built in 1395 and does not have modern safety features. Parents and Carers are reminded that they must take responsibility for the safety of the children in their care and follow any guidance or instruction made by church staff.
