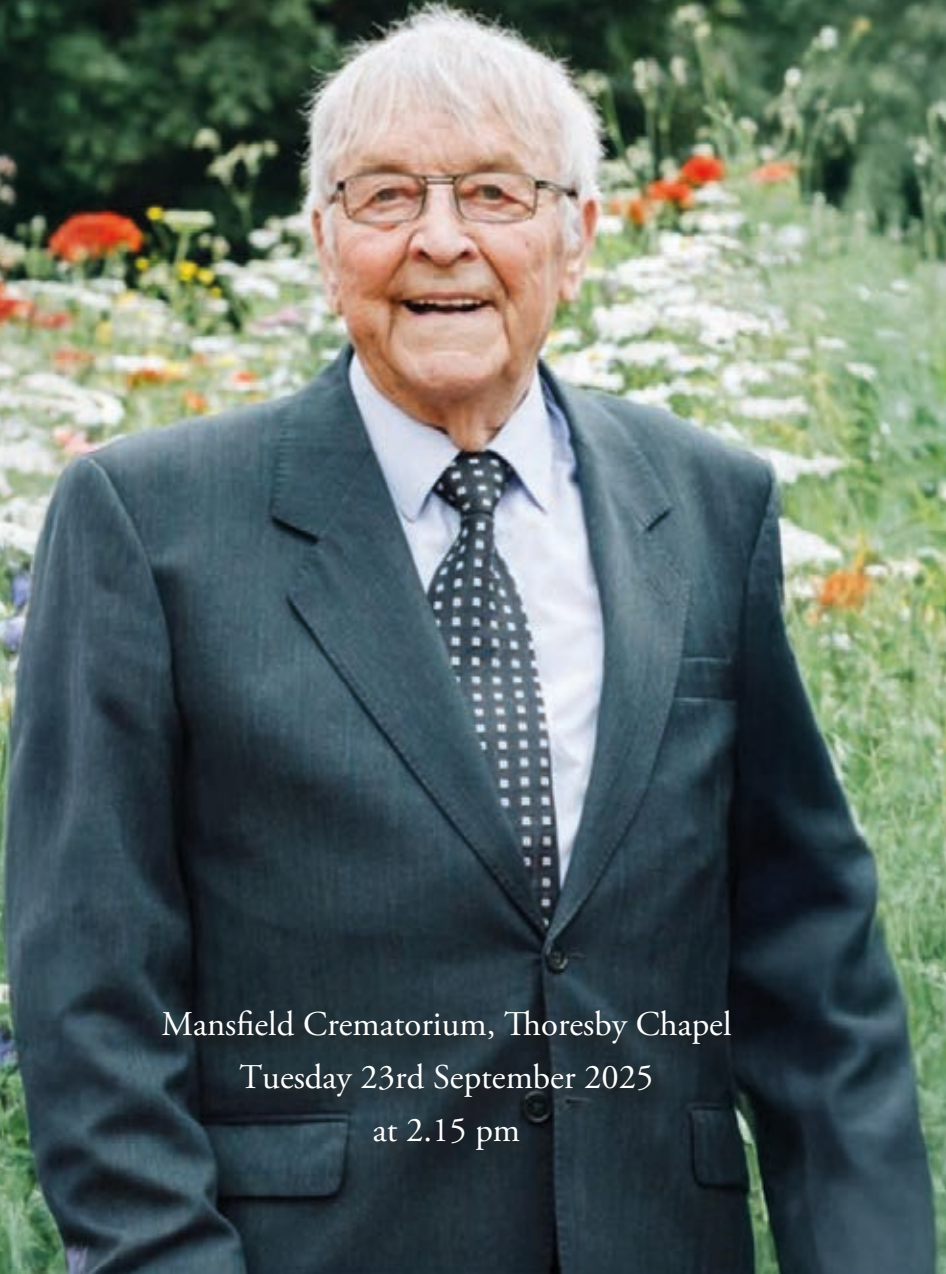

All things bright and beautiful...


The purple headed mountain,

He knew that you were suffering, He knew you were in pain.


He knew that you would never get well on earth again.
