

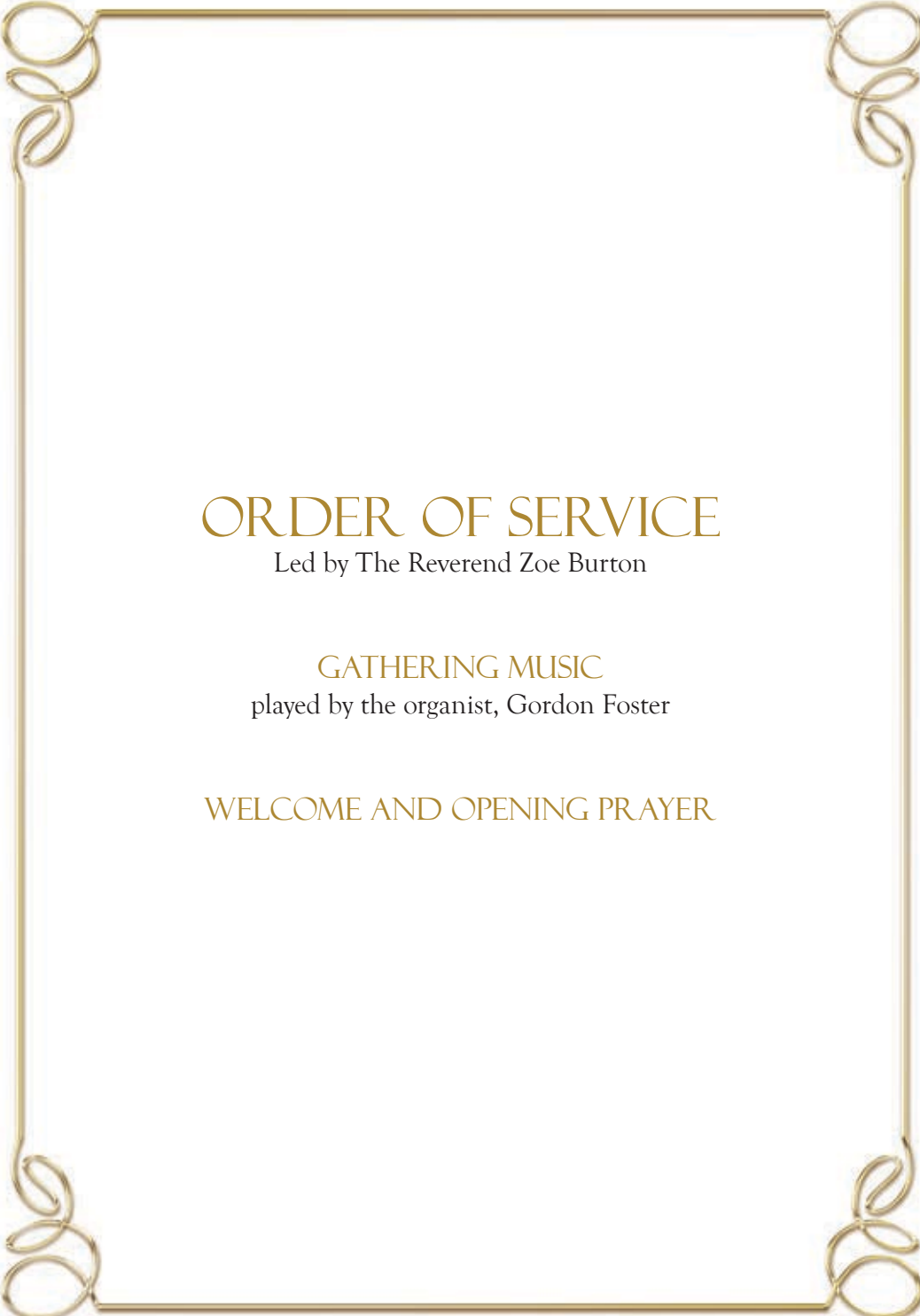

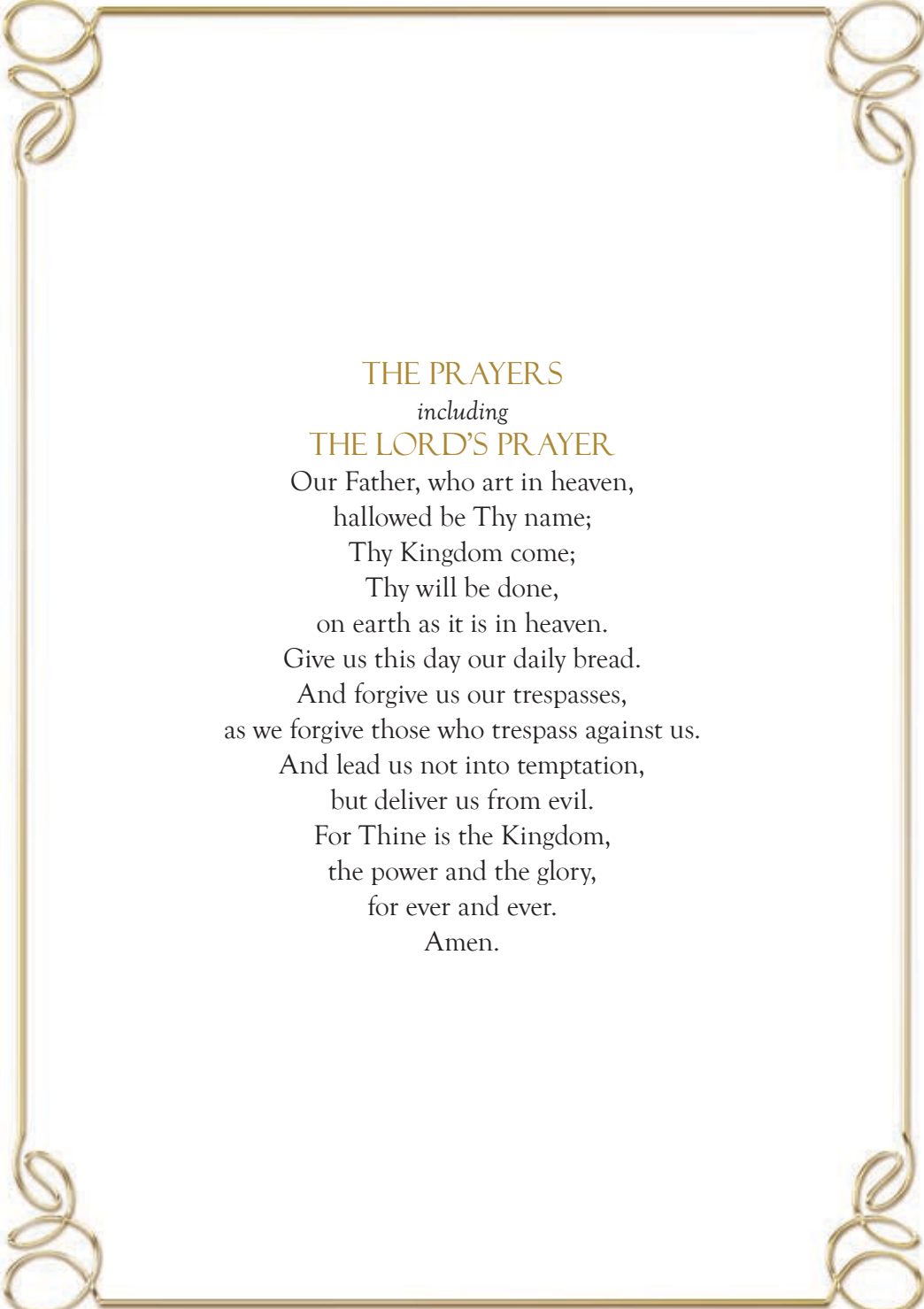
Make me a channel of Your peace.

Thy power throughout the universe displayed;

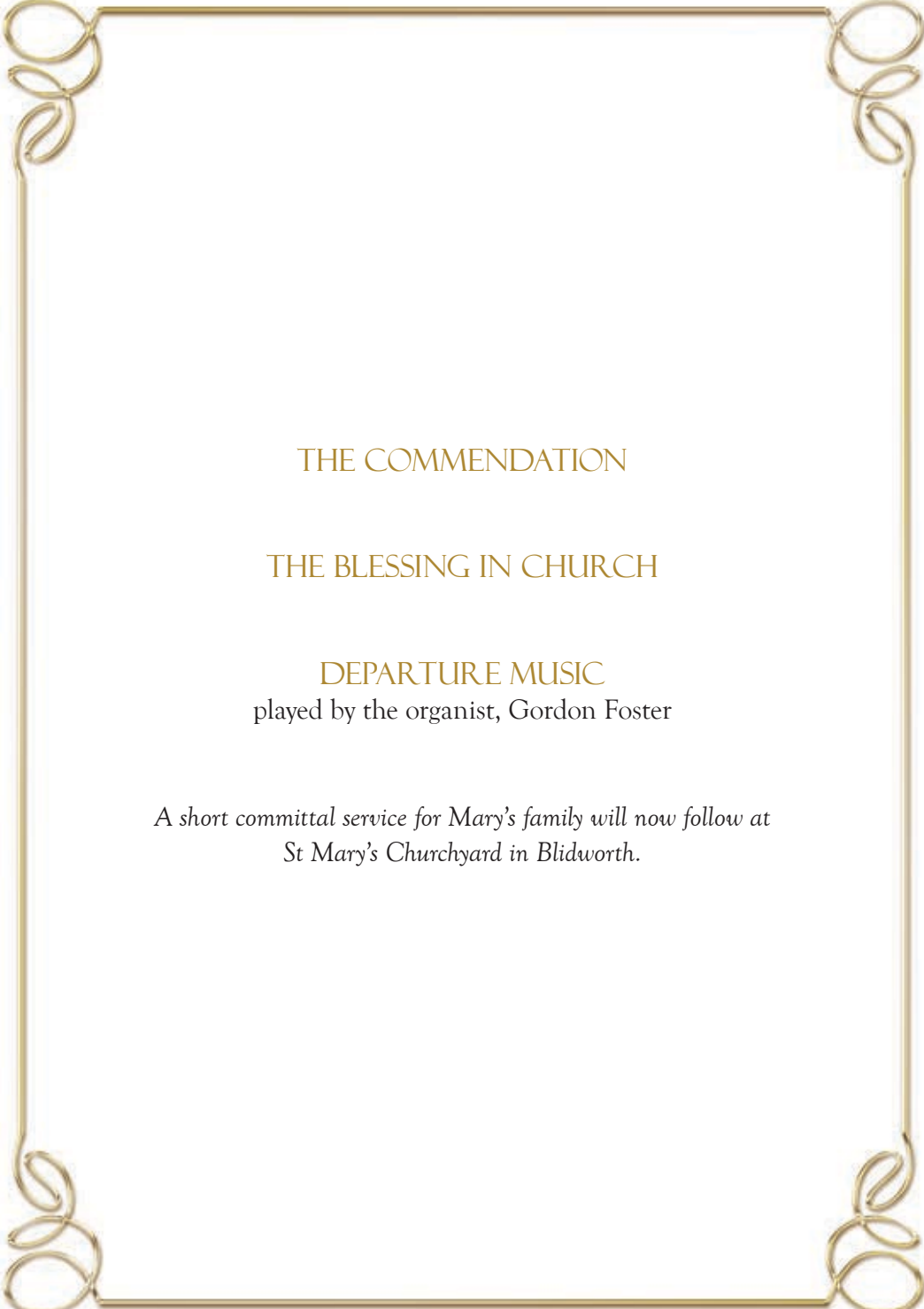
*Then sings my soul, my Saviour God, to Thee,
