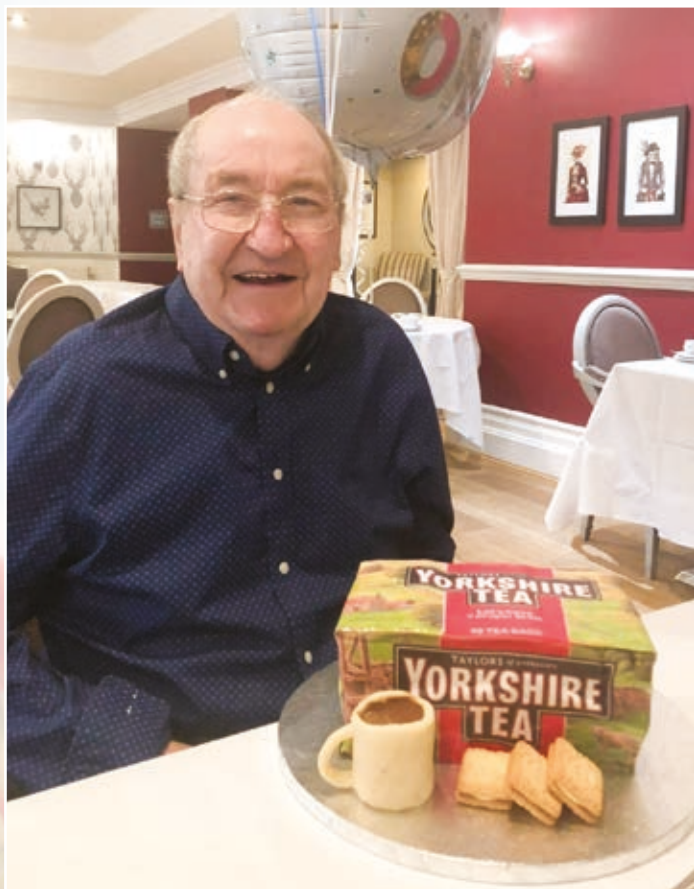

and just as able to bear her load of living freight to its destination.


The diminished size and total loss of sight is in me, not in her,
