> So I'll cherish the old rugged cross, Till my trophies at last I lay down; I will cling to the old rugged cross, And exchange it some day for a crown.



'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, And grace my fears relieved; How precious did that grace appear The hour I first believed!


Through many dangers, toils and snares
