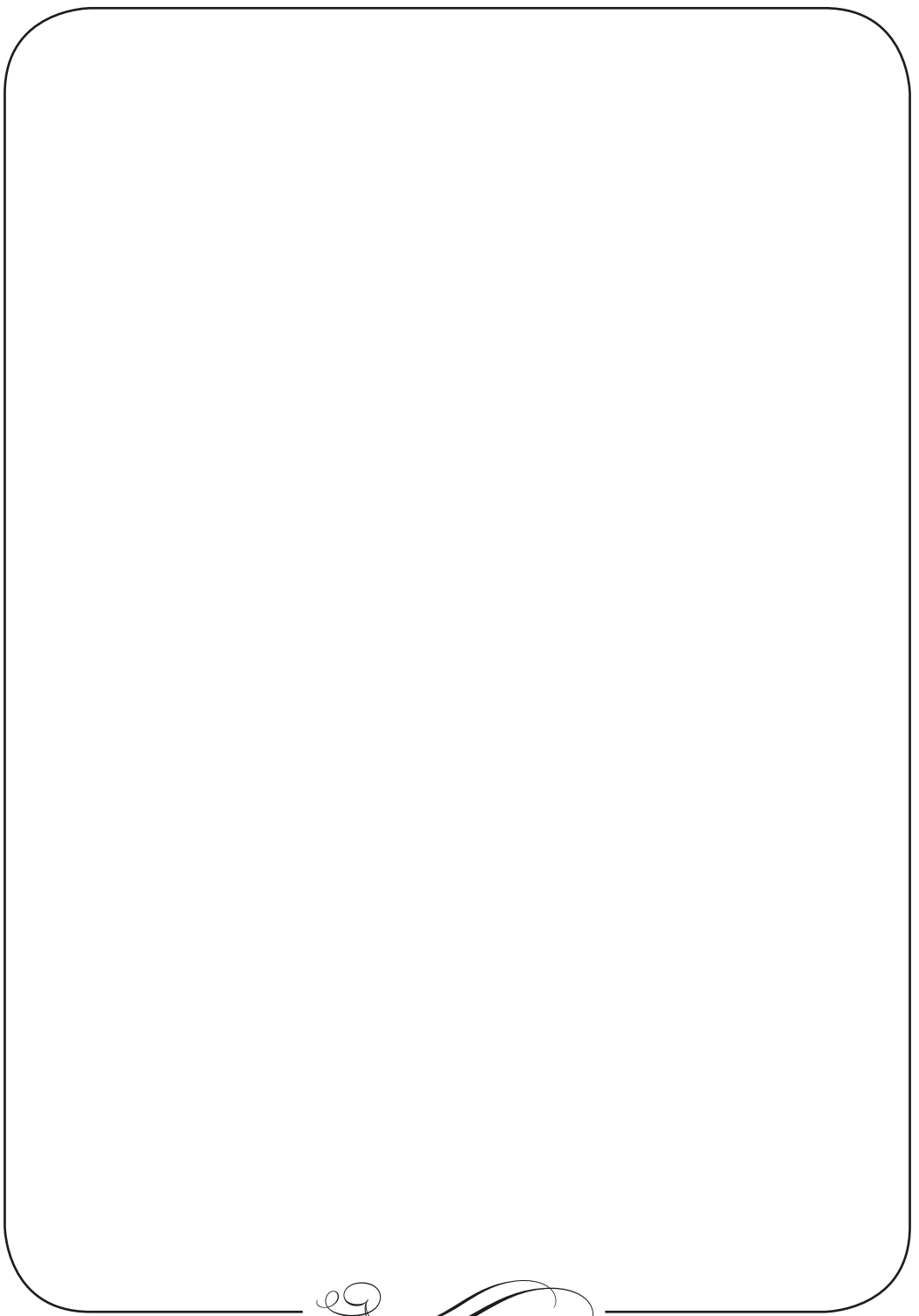
On that bright and cloudless morning when the dead in Christ shall rise,
